Amateur Teams Challenge Rules

The Amateur Teams Challenge program is an event to promote camaraderie but will offer a demonstration of the skill that Amateurs boast.

The Amateur Teams Challenge will consist of four (3) members which are to be drawn randomly on the (Insert Date), at the (Insert Venue). No Teams are to be pre-organised.

Cost is \$5.00 per team members and this amount is to be paid along with the completed entry form.

THE CHALLENGE

Each Team Member may nominate two (2) events only, in which the points will tally towards the Team High Point. Team Members may use one (1) or two (2) horses as per AQHA Rules and Regulations. The events for each Team Member will be decided once the Teams have been organised. No American Amateur events are to be used.

All AQHA Rules and Regulations apply but not limited to those pertaining to Amateur Competition refer to the appropriate Sections of the AQHA Official Handbook.

Each discipline is judged as per AQHA Rules and Regulations. Teams are to be presented in full show attire, with each member dressed according to AQHA Rules and Regulations for their respective discipline.

Points will be allocated on a 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, or pro-rata if less than six (6) entrants per class.

All Junior & Senior Amateur & Select Amateur events at each show are eligible for points to be counted towards the Team Challenge. (Including Am Halter)

Awards will be presented at the completion of the Show, along with the High Point presentations.

In the event of a tie for first place, the tie will be split using AQHA Rule 45.19e. 1)
